- Include copy of the receipt & warranty paper work that was filled out & returned within 30 days AS STATED IN THE WARRANTY PAPERS included with the engine.
- Include receipts for NEW oil coolers & oil cooler lines or any other parts related to the nature of the failure.
- Verify the installer used an evacuation system for the cooling system or engine damage may occur. Verify the oil system was primed using air over hydraulic system or similar, not the starter!
- Include all receipts documenting oil changes, new cooling system parts, etc. (Oil samples will show if there was water in the oil).
- Include receipts for new or remanufactured turbo, injector pump, high pressure pump. Much like the OEM manufactures, any aftermarket parts will void the warranty.
- Include fuel system receipts: Injectors must have been cleaned & tested OR new injectors, fuel pumps, etc. Some engine failures are the result of a bad fuel system that can over fuel the cylinder & cause cylinder damage. No warranty for damaged or burnt pistons. This is a sign of a bad injector.
- No claims for burnt bearings, this is a result of lack of lubrication.
- Make sure to include a completed warranty checklist with your claim.
- Make sure the reason for the claim states the REASON for the failure. We need to determine the
  cause for any failure not simply what is damaged with the engine but the cause of the damage or
  failure.
